

HumanX and Humanrace Capital Launch The Al Coalition: Giving Early-Stage Al Companies a Voice in Washington

New nonprofit coalition ensures emerging Al innovators aren't left behind as Congress and agencies draft once-in-a-generation legislation

New York, October 2025 - HumanX and Humanrace Capital today announced the launch of The Al Coalition, the first nonprofit specifically designed to provide early-stage Al companies, from pre-seed through Series B, with meaningful access to policymakers and influence over the regulations that will define the next decade of innovation.

The coalition launches as Congress and the administration continue to work on historic federal Al initiatives, ensuring that the voices shaping America's Al future aren't limited to tech giants and incumbents with full-time Washington lobbying teams.

Bridging the Policy Gap for Emerging AI Leaders

The coalition was born from HumanX's successful engagement with policymakers, including bringing Congressman Jay Obernolte (R-CA), Chair of the Bipartisan House Al Task Force, to speak at the HumanX conference in Las Vegas earlier this year - a groundbreaking moment that demonstrated the power of connecting innovative Al companies directly with legislative leaders.

"Congress needs to hear from the front lines of the Al ecosystem, the startups and emerging companies deploying Al to create breakthrough products and services." Said Rep. Jay Obernolte. "I'm excited for the Al Coalition to bring these innovators to the table in the policymaking process where they belong."

"Many lawmakers have told me they only hear from the biggest players in AI," says Stefan Weitz, co-founder & CEO of HumanX. "This coalition gives earlier-stage companies doing transformative work in healthcare, finance, cybersecurity, and beyond a unique opportunity to engage directly with federal policymakers and ensure the rules work for all - not just the incumbents."

Comprehensive Policy Access at Startup-Friendly Prices

The Al Coalition offers five core benefits designed specifically for resource-conscious early-stage companies:

 Direct Policymaker Engagement: Members receive structured, regular access to federal, state, and local decision-makers through quarterly touchpoints and twice-yearly Washington D.C.

- 2) **Affordable Policy Expertise:** Services that usually come at a huge cost for individual lobbying are available through the coalition's sliding-scale membership model, including real-time regulatory updates, strategic guidance, and a "bat phone" for urgent policy matters.
- 3) National Policy Influence: The coalition coordinates member positions on critical legislation, including the upcoming federal Al modernization bill, and advocates collectively for member interests in congressional debates.
- 4) **Business Development Opportunities:** Membership unlocks partnerships and integration pathways with federal agencies, plus networking with Fortune 500 companies and sovereign nations through the coalition's Strategic Advisory Council.
- 5) **Strategic Ecosystem Networking:** Face-to-face connections with peers, competitors, and key Al ecosystem players through quarterly summits and exclusive events.

Urgent Timing as AI Regulation Accelerates

The coalition launches at a critical moment for Al policy. With the removal of a moratorium on state-level Al regulation from recent federal legislation, early-stage companies face a complex patchwork of emerging rules across multiple jurisdictions.

"Al will unlock the next generation of care delivery, but only if Al native builders, who don't have the resources to navigate complex state-by-state regulations, are enabled to build that future." Said Izac Ross, Founder & CEO, Haven Headache & Migraine Center. "We see the Al Coalition as a key partner in bringing builders and policymakers together to keep regulation aligned with real-world innovation in healthcare and enable us to close the gap in headache and migraine care. "
